PUBLIC NOTICE The City of Elizabeth is updating its jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan – Natural Hazards that complies with the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000). The Hazard Mitigation Plan – Natural Hazards provides the framework for state and local governments to evaluate and mitigate natural hazards as a condition of receiving Federal disaster assistance. The Hazard Mitigation Plan – Natural Hazards identifies and prioritizes the likelihood of damage to life and property from natural disasters and develops a strategic plan to minimize identified risks. As part of the process, the City intended to host public meetings to obtain public input on potential natural hazards; however due to the current COVID-19 restrictions, the first presentation is being provided as a slide show and video presentation.
