The City of Elizabeth Department of Planning and Community Development will submit a revised CD-46 (2020-2021) Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) to the United States Department of housing and Urban Development (HUD) on or about January 15, 2022. The CAPER is an annual report of the activities and the usage of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Grant (HOME), and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) by Elizabeth's Planning and Community Development Department for Fiscal Year 2020 (July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021).

Plan will be revised to reflect outcomes for CARES ACT Funds addressing COVID-19 in PY2021, a revised plan will be available for review by the public, beginning Thursday, December 30, 2021, (9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) until end of 15-day commentary period, Thursday, January 13, 2022, (12 noon).
